MODIFICATION TO THE 2003-2004 FINANCIAL PLAN INCLUDING APPROVAL AND CERTIFICATION OF ADDITIONAL SALES TAX REVENUES AND AUTHORIZATION OF THE MAYOR TO WITHHOLD CERTAIN FIREFIGHTER LAYOFFS

WHEREAS, on March 1, 2004 the Mayor of the City of Buffalo submitted a request for BFSA approval for two (2) modifications to the 2003-2004 Four-Year Financial Plan that had been approved by the BFSA and

WHEREAS, the first modification that the Mayor requests is for BFSA to certify \$1.8 million in additional sales tax revenues, and

WHEREAS, BFSA staff has confirmed that the additional sales tax revenue will be realized by the City in the 2003-2004 fiscal year, and

WHEREAS, the second modification that the Mayor requests is for BFSA to authorize the retention of fire department personnel originally scheduled for layoff, and

WHEREAS, the layoff of firefighters at this time will likely produce extra expenses for the City in the current fiscal year due to the use of overtime by firefighters, and

WHEREAS, the motion on the floor of the March 10, 2004 meeting was tabled, and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT, the BFSA approves and certifies the \$1.8 million in additional revenues and the retention of fire department personnel originally scheduled for layoff in the 2003-2004 Four-Year Financial Plan.

This resolution shall take effect immediately.
