#### **INTRODUCTION**

New York State Public Officers Law §87(3)(c) stipulates that the Buffalo Fiscal Stability Authority (the “BFSA”) shall maintain: “a reasonably detailed current list by subject matter, of all records in possession of the [BFSA], whether or not available under [New York State Freedom of Information Law]. [BFSA] shall update its subject matter list annually, and the date of the most recent update shall be conspicuously indicated on the list...”

Certain records contain personal or confidential information and may not be released; other information is a matter of public record and may be obtained either free of charge or for a nominal copying fee. Various statutes, rules, and regulations govern records access and may define specific fees. Records that are deemed to have significant historical value will be retained indefinitely.
